September 13, 2023

A record of a legally convened meeting of the Environmental and Forestry Commission of the Village of Winnetka, which was held in the Council Chambers at Village Hall, 510 Green Bay Road, Winnetka, Illinois, Wednesday, September 12, 2023, at 7:00 p.m.

Call to Order:

Chairperson Hanley called the meeting to order at 7:01 p.m.; Voting Members present: Commissioners Patrick Hanley, Peter Eck, Brendan Andrew and Tim Ring. Voting Members absent: Liz Kunkle, Gregory Frezados and David Varca. A quorum of presently appointed members was present. Village Council Representative present: Robert Dearborn. Student Representative Present: Scarlett Harper. Interim Staff Liaison present: Erik Jensen, Assistant Public Works Director. Public present: Berina Gradjan.

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1) Introduction & Chair's Remarks:

Chairperson Hanley called the meeting to order at 7:01 p.m. and welcomed all Commission members. Interim Staff Representative Jensen took roll call for attendance. Chairperson Hanley welcomed the newly appointed EFC Commissioner Tim Ring.

Chairperson Hanley briefly overviewed his vision that individual Commissioners could pursue their interests related to sustainability and use the Commission as a way to evaluate ideas and

- D) Student Representative Harper: New Trier High School Improvements and lessons to be learned and shared.
- E) Commissioner Eck: Compilation of community carbon assessments to determine best practices.
